## **MEET CONDITIONS**

Meet Location:	University of Limerick		
Date	Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> March, 2024		
Sessions:	9am Warm up 10 am start		
Age:	Age as 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2024		
Qualification	Swimmers must be at least 13 years of age by 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2024.		
Criteria:	Relay Age Groups 13-16 and 17 & over		
Heats & Finals:	All events will be HDW and will be Long Course There will be no finals		
Withdrawals:	Withdrawals from day 1 must be emailed to <u>munsterentries@swimireland.ie</u> before 5pm on the day before the start of the meet, Saturday 2 <sup>nd</sup> March There will be a €50 fine if swimmers are not withdrawn by 5pm for an event for the next day.		
Entry Deadline:	Entries on Hy-Tek only to <u>munsterentries@swimireland.ie</u> to be received on or before Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> February.		
Entry Fees:	Individual entries cost €7 per event. Relay entries cost €20 per event.		
	No entry will be processed until the appropriate fee has been received by the Treasurer. Fees should be paid directly into the bank account, and must include the name of the club and the name of the meet at least 10 days before the meet. Bank details BIC – AIBKIE2D IBAN – IE70AIBK93251559772394 Please note that entries are non-refundable once the final date for payment has passed. The date for payment is 23 <sup>rd</sup> February.		
Individual Entries :	Entries will be limited to 4 events per day. There are no qualifying times, but where a swimmer has a time this should be submitted.		
	SwimMunster reserve the right to limit the number of swims per swimmer at the meet to ensure that the meet is within permitted time restrictions. SwimMunster reserves the right to limit the number of entries in the 400/800/1500m events. This will be assessed upon receipt of all entries. This provision is particularly relevant with the increase in permitted number of swims		
Relay Entries:	Clubs are permitted to enter more than one relay team per event. The names of the 4 relay team members swimming in the race and the order of swimming must be declared on the official Team Declaration Sheet and submitted to the Swim Office Table no later than 45 minutes before the start of the session in which the race takes place. Failure to do so will be subject to a fine of €50 without exception and disqualification of the relay team.		
	All competing relay swimmers must be entered in the meet. Relay teams that swim in an order that is different from the declared order of swimming shall be disqualified in accordance with FINA Rule SW 10.12.		
Awards:	Bands will be awarded to all swimmers for each event where they meet the time standard.
