Relay Events:	12&Under - 4x25 mixed freestyle (minimum one athlete per gender, no restriction on age group)
	13-14yrs, 15&over – 4x25/50/75/100 mixed freestyle (2 boys and 2 girls)
Entries:	All swimmers entering the Munster Swim Festival must be a member of a Swim Munster affiliated club.
	Swim Munster reserves the right to limit entries if the meet is oversubscribed. If the meet is oversubscribed the number of swims per swimmer will be limited and any rejected entries will be refunded as a single payment to the club in question.

Lifti y Form.	Team Manager. The Swim Ireland Registration number or equivalent for each swimmer must be included in the file.
Eligibility:	All the swimmers who have not obtained a Consideration Time for the Irish Summer Age groups, Youth and Senior Championship are eligible to compete.
	Any swimmer who has a Summer Nationals Consideration Time is ineligible, regardless of whether that swimmer entered the Summer Nationals or not.
	Slower Than Entry Times – Irish Summer National Championships. If a club is found to have entered a swimmer who has achieved an Irish Summer National Championship consideration standard the club will be levied with a fine of £100. It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that all entered swimmers are eligible to compete.
Seeding:	The placing of competitors in the heats will be spearheaded from slowest to fastest
Heats & Finals:	All the individual events and relays will be swum as HDW.
	Morning Session super final: the best 10 swimmers per age group and gender (11-12 only) considering the 4 combined points (based on placing) can progress to the "Super-Final" on the 100 IM.

	Afternoon Session skin race: the best 10 swimmers per age group and gender (13-14 and 15&O) considering the points achieved across their 4 best placed events can progress to the Medley Skin Race

Withdrawals:	Withdrawals must be emailed to <u>munsterentries@swimireland.ie</u> before 5pm on the day before the start of the meet, i.e. Saturday 22 nd June 2023.
Entry Deadline:	Closing date for entries is 12:00 noon on 10 th of June 2023.
Entry Fees:	€30 per swimmer, covering all the individual events, relay participation and final. Fees should be paid directly into the bank account by Friday 14 th and must include the name of the club and the name of the meet.

	No entry will be processed until the appropriate fee has been received by the Treasurer.
	Please note that all entry fees are payable and non-refundable once the final date for payment (14 th June 2024) has passed.
Awards:	Medals are awarded for top 3 placings in each age group for each individual event; All the swimmers qualified for the "Super Final" and the "Medley Skin Race" will be awarded special awards
Relay Entries:	Clubs are permitted to enter more than one relay team per event. The names of the 4 relay team members swimming in the race and the order of swimming must be declared on the official Team Declaration Sheet and submitted to the Swim Office Table no later than 60 minutes before the start of the session in which the race takes place. To reduce administration, relay entries will be very welcome in the days before the event.
	All competing swimmers must be entered in the meet (<i>even if they are not swimming in individual events</i>). Relay teams that swim in an order that is different from the declared order of swimming shall be disqualified in accordance with FINA Rule SW 10.12.
	Swimmers can compete in their respective age group only. Swimmers aged 10 to 12 are not allowed to "swim up" in the 13&O age group in relays
Anti-Doping:	It is a condition of attending a Swim Ireland event that swimmers may be required to be tested for prohibited substances in accordance with the Sport Ireland/WADA/FINA Anti-Doping rules. For further information visit the <u>Anti-Doping section of the Sport Ireland</u> <u>website</u> .
Swimsuits:	Athletes aged 12 years and younger will not be permitted to compete at this meet in a tech suit. A tech suit is defined as any male or female swimsuit manufactured using fabric with water-repellent properties or using any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric. Athletes aged 12 years and under will be disqualified if officials observe such an athlete competing in a tech suit.
	Athletes over 12 may compete in a TechSuit but it must comply with FINA regulations and should bear the FINA approved stamp (<u>https://www.fina.org/sites/default/files/frsa.pdf</u>)
Health & Safety:	Please refer to the Health & Safety guidelines at the back of the programme and also the Swim Ireland Code of Practice for Safety (Swimming) on the Swim Ireland website.
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Photography is prohibited on the pool deck and changing area. A registration desk will be in place in the balcony area. All devices, capable of taking an image, must be registered in advance.
All persons wishing to register a device must provide: name, address, contact number and photographic identification. In the case where photographic ID is not available Swim Ireland membership card will be accepted with the member's ID number recorded. Any person using the equipment must wear a tag that is clearly visible when using the equipment. If this photographic rule is breached, members are subject to the Swim Ireland Complaints
and Disciplinary Rules and Procedures. Once registered, photographs are permitted from the balcony. A Munster Backdrop will be in situ on the balcony from where photographs may be taken.

Entries may be limited to ensure compliance with SI licence rules. Where entries have been limited clubs will be informed when all entries have been processed.

All competing clubs must provide at least one official per six swimmers per session up to a maximum of four officials per session. These Meet Conditions must be read in conjunction with the Swim Ireland General Event Rules available on the Swim Ireland website at http://www.swimireland.ie/competitions-events/regulations-and-safety

Superfinal: the top 10 swimmers combined points across all the individual events (max 4) swam by each swimmer will compete for the 100 im superfinal (one final for each gender and age group). Points are calculated by the Meet Manager software based on the placing of the swimmer in each event.

In the event of a tie for 10th place , a swim off will take place between the relevant swimmers over 50m Freestyle heat until a winner is declared.

Medley Skin Race: the best 10 swimmers overall (considering the combined points achieved across their 4 best placed events) are qualified for the 4 Medley Skin Races (one per gender per age group); in case of a tie selecting the 10 swimmers for the

"skin race", will be disputed a "swim-off" on a 50 freestyle.

In the event of a tie for 10th place , a swim off will take place between the relevant swimmers over 50m Freestyle heat until a winner is declared.

The skin race stages alternate between boys and girls per each age group as follows

Stage 1: all the swimmers qualified are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager; the first 8 proceed to stage 2. Boys race and Girls race.
Stage 2: the remaining 8 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager (among the 3 remaining); the first 6 proceed to stage 3. Boys race and Girls race.

Stage 3: the remaining 6 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager (among the 2 remaining); the first 4 proceed to stage 4. Boys race and Girls race.

Stage 4: the remaining 4 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is the last remaining not previously swum in stage 1-2-3; the first 2 proceed to stage 5. Boys race and Girls race.

Stage 5: the remaining 2 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the is drawn by the competition manager (among all the 4 strokes); the winner is the overall winner of the event.

4x25/50/75/100m Freestyle Mixed Relay: Each Team must have 2 boys and 2 girls (13&Over); each team swims the 4 distances in the specific order: one 25 – one 50 – one 75 – one 100. The order of the swimmers (boys or girls first) is open to each team.
